NEW BUSINESS

1. **Discussion/Possible Approval of Resolution 17 – 05 Resolution of the Planning and Zoning Commission of the Town of Superior, Pinal County, recommending that the Town Council approve the Public Art Proposal by the Superior Chamber of Commerce.**
Juliana Brutsche is the Project coordinator for the Public Art Project which is a creation and implementation of a painted mural, approximately 12' x 24', on the west wall of the Superior Senior Center building located on Main Street. The concept drawing is an "old time postcard" design: "Greeting from Superior, Arizona". Each letter in the word "SUPERIOR" would have a different design. Juliana suggested the individual letters could have a cultural or historic picture. This could bring in local artists as well as from around the state. Each artist would submit one

picture per letter. The pictures could be posted on websites and people could give the feedback. Then there would be a vote on the selected designs.

The question was brought up about the longevity and maintenance of the mural. Juliana stated high-quality paint and seal would be used which would protect against sun damage.

Todd Pryor, Town Manager, asked if mural paint would be compatible with base paint on the building since it had just been painted. Juliana stated it looked like it had the proper surface but she would have to look at it.

Artist used would be local artists, artists with ties to Superior and outside artist which would bring people to Superior.

Hank Gutierrez liked the concept and asked about time constraint. Juliana answered it all depends on the artist's schedules.


